Hi Margaret, here are SCEs' comments. Thank you.

Southern California Edison appreciates the opportunity to provide input on proposed revisions to Station Protocol for MRTU. CAISO proposed several options for settlement of Station Power Load under MRTU. SCE supports Option 3 in which all Station Power Load settles, whether self-supplied or third-party supplied, at the resource specific LMP (or as the CAISO has described this option, at a custom Load Aggregation Point LAP at that location). Under MRTU's LMP pricing system, using nodal prices best reflects the true cost of serving station load, and most accurately prices the energy used to served the load from a CAISO's settlement perspective.

SCE believes this option should be updated in the tariff language for the Station Power Protocol in November 2007.

By noting a preference among the options provided by the CAISO, SCE is not waiving any legal argument, including the argument that load served from the imbalance market that is "settled" is not in fact being self-supplied but rather is being purchased in a retail transaction.
