Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) hereby submits its initial comments on the California Independent System Operator’s (“CAISO”) Draft 2009 CAISO Transmission Study Plan (“Plan”), dated March 2008.

I. Introduction

SCE appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Draft 2009 CAISO Transmission Plan. Below are SCE’s specific comments to the CAISO’s 2009 Transmission Plan:

II. Assumption for Mohave Plant

SCE acknowledges that the CAISO is continuously applying the assumption that the Mohave Plant is in operation and serves loads between the years of 2013 through 2018. The Mohave Plant does not intend to operate during the years 2013 through 2018. Therefore, SCE recommends the CAISO to revise its generation assumption to reflect the Mohave Plant as non-operational between the years of 2013 to 2018.

III. Transmission Planning Process (TPP) Integration

The CAISO has recently proposed a Generation Interconnection Process Reform (“GIPR”) initiative to improve upon the efficiency of the current applicant queue management process so that viable interconnection projects can enter into the CAISO’s annual TPP. In order to support the CAISO in achieving a successful GIPR implementation, SCE recommends the

CAISO ensure better integration between TPP with its newly proposed generation interconnection process.
