

FTR Holder Registration Form

Applicability

All FTR Market Participants, including entities participating in secondary FTR markets.

Background

Per section 9.2.7 of the ISO Tariff, all entities that acquire Firm Transmission Rights (FTRs) by participating in the ISO's primary FTR auction, or by purchasing FTRs in secondary markets, must register as a FTR Holder with the ISO. FTR Holders must notify the ISO of all entities that the FTR Holder is affiliated with that are FTR Holders or Market Participants as defined in the ISO tariff.

An Affiliate is an entity, company, or person that directly, or indirectly through one or more intermediaries, controls, or is controlled by, or is under common control with the subject entity, company, or person.

This notification requirement is a continuing obligation, and FTR Holders must provide the ISO with subsequent notifications concerning affiliated entities within five (5) business days.
